Tips for Renewing Applicants:

- Please make sure you have ample time to complete the application before you start (we estimate the time ranging between 15 - 30 minutes depending on your category and computer proficiency) as you will need to submit the application to save any of your updates. If there are documents that you do not have, you can upload them to your profile after submission when you receive them.
- If you do not see a required document present in your profile, that means that we do not currently have a copy.
- As this form is somewhat one-size-fits-all, there may be questions that don't apply to you. If this is the case, please enter not applicable (N/A).
- We strongly recommend paying for your renewal fee when prompted after your renewal submission to lock in your early bird discount.

New Applicants:

You will need photos of your products and booth (or a diagram of how you plan to setup your booth).

New Applicant - Farmers:

You will need a digital copy (format- pdf, however a clear photo will suffice if the document is only a single page) of the following:

- All of your Certified Producer Certificates
- State and 3rd Party Organic Certifications if you are certified organic
- Nursery Stock License if requesting to sell flowers
- CDFA Egg Handlers Certificate if requesting to sell eggs

New Applicant - Fishers:

You will need a digital copy (format- pdf, however a clear photo will suffice if the document is only a single page) of the following:

- Commercial Fishing License
- Fish Business Receipt
- Fish Retail License
- Vessel Registration
- 2 recent landing receipts

Food Purveyor/Pre-Packaged

No additional documents needed for submission of your application. Additional documents (e.g. insurance, PFR or CFO, county health permit etc.) will be required if approved to join our markets.

New Applicant - Dairy and Cheese Producers:

You will need a digital copy (format- pdf, however a clear photo will suffice if the document is only a single page) of the following:

- Milk Products Plant License
- CDFA Milk Handlers License
- State and 3rd Party Organic Certifications if you are certified organic
- CPC and CDFA Egg Handlers Certificate if requesting to sell eggs

New Applicant - Ranchers:

You will need a digital copy (format- pdf, however a clear photo will suffice if the document is only a single page) of the following:

- State and 3rd Party Organic Certifications if you are certified organic
- CPC and CDFA Egg Handlers Certificate if requesting to sell eggs
- Any 3rd party certifications you possess

Additional documents (e.g. insurance, county health permit etc.) will be required if approved to join our markets.

New Applicant - TFF Temporary Food Facility/MFF Mobile Food Facility (on-site consumption):

You will need a digital copy (format- pdf, however a clear photo will suffice if the document is only a single page) of the following:

- California Sellers Permit

Additional documents (e.g. insurance, county health permit etc.) will be required if approved to join our markets.

New Applicant - Artisans

You will need clear photos of:

- you working in your studio
- your event booth
- 5 photos of your product offerings

Additional documents (e.g. insurance, California seller's permit etc.) will be required if approved to join our markets.

New Applicant - Entertainers/Free Speech/Commercial/Community Partner/Non-profit

The application should not take you long and requires little documentation. Please feel free to skip sections that don't apply to you (if they are required, just input N/A into the field) as the bulk of the application is geared towards producers of food and artisans.
